The Jaguar II has evolved to become the Jag II Pro and now features a pre-strung bow, allowing for hassle-free assembly. It is also equipped with vibration reducing string stoppers, which makes it even quieter and more durable. Its new ergonomic pistol grip gives the user a comfortable

hold and stabilises the operator's ability to acquire the target with the Jag II Pro's tactical red-dot sight.

The barrel features a patented aluminium rail and anti-dry-fire trigger mechanism, giving this crossbow everything the user could want in a compact and easy to use package.

This crossbow will put holes through a bull's-eye without putting a hole in your pocket.

The Guillotine M Pro is a crossbow that the enthusiast would be drawn towards. Expanding on the stable frame of the original high-velocity Guillotine M, the new upgraded edition emphasises on stealth, with string stoppers and silencers. The reduction in vibration results in a hand-shock that is minimal and a sound signature that is sure to impress retailers and consumers alike.

High-end machined cams, a bull-pup-style trigger mechanism and a strengthened anti-dry-fire safety system make the M Pro a very solid and consistent shooting platform.
