introduced the revolutionary Cobra R9 crossbow, which can be broken down into small components for transport in a discreet case or backpack, then rapidly reassembled without the need for tools. This compact crossbow features interchangeable 90lb and 110lb recurve limb sets and is easily cycled by women and children using a patented built-in cocking lever.

By eliminating unwieldy cocking ropes and winch systems, the cocking process that plagues traditional crossbows is eliminated. The R9 proved a popular product that resonated with survivalists by meeting the requirements that every piece of gear be compact, lightweight and field-serviceable. Later in the same year, Ek Archery introduced the enhanced target model, the Cobra RX, built on the same R-series platform but featuring more powerful 130lb limbs, giving the crossbow an increased range and lethality.

#### A TRULY TACTICAL CROSSBOW: THE RX ADDER

Even though the cocking lever system of the Cobra R9/RX affords a significantly faster cycling process, manual reloading still limits the rate of fire. To remedy this limitation Ek Archery rolled out the widely sought-after Cobra RX Adder in 2019. A modernised version of the famous repeating Chu-ko-nu crossbow, the Adder features a unique five-shot top loaded magazine, developed in cooperation with Jörg Sprave of the Slingshot Channel. This evolution in modern crossbow design allows for rapid follow up shots and transforms the R-Series platform into an effective close-range defensive weapon.

The design of the magazine's retention arm allows the RX Adder to be operated while running and easily reloaded in the dark. The Adder is configured with three-point Picatinny rails to allow for

tactical aftermarket accessories and comes prepackaged with optics and bolts ready to shoot “out of the box”.

#### THE NEED FOR SPEED: EK'S NEWEST ADDITION

The latest progeny of the R-Series, this year's Siege 300 is a nod to modern hunting crossbows; a compound limb set with a narrow axle-to-axle profile. Matt Liu explains: “It was our aim from the beginning to bring a true compact hunting platform into the R-Series family but it needed to have all of the versatility of its predecessors.”

The Siege 300 has all of the ground-breaking design and ergonomic attributes of the R9/RX but it is fortified to take the punishment of use in less than ideal field conditions. Constructed around a robust safety system the Siege has a new reinforced cocking arm and hardened components to strengthen the device to the rigours of

firing at faster speeds. Like the newest generation of user-friendly vertical compound bows, the Siege's limb bolts can be adjusted to produce draw weights between an easy 118lb and a stiff 150lb. The Siege also ships with a pair of preset 90lb limb bolts that allow almost every age of operator the ability to cycle the device. While the 150lb compound limb set module is not interchangeable with earlier models it is designed to allow the operator to change the bowstring and cables in the field without the hassles of a bowpress. In comparison to the RX's 130lb recurve limbs propelling a 240gn bolt at 240fps; the Siege 300 propels a 283gn bolt at 300fps giving it the flat trajectory and kinetic energy that makes it ideal for both bush hunting and mid-range defensive applications.
